The payment mode may be direct deposit or bank transfer to the Gov. **Revenue A/c title No.14227(Office code No. 27-331-04, A/C No. ka-1-1-999)** on Nepal Rastra Bank, Thapathali, Kathmandu, Nepal or Bankers cheque payable to Department of Hydrology and Meteorology, Kathmandu, Nepal.
5. Documents received after submission deadline shall not be accepted.

Bids shall be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend on the opening date given in above Table **at the office of Department of Hydrology and Meteorology, P.o.box 406, Babarmahal, Kathmandu, Nepal**. Bids must be valid for a period as indicated in table above counting from the day of bid opening and must be accompanied by bid security, amount and validity period as given in above table. If the bidder wishes to submit the Bid Security in the form of cash, the cash should be deposited in Account No. **Sa. A. 131414/070** at Nepal Rastra Bank, Thapathali, Kathmandu and submit the receipt along with the bid.
7. If the last date of purchasing, submission and opening falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered the last day. In such a case the bid validity and bid security validity shall be recognized with effect from the original bid submission deadline.
8. Bids should comply in all respects with the Instruction to Bidder included in the Bid Document. Non compliance with these instructions shall result in disqualification.
