4. Pre-bid meeting shall be held at **Department of Hydrology and Meteorology, Babarmahal, Kathmandu at 13:00 pm, 2080/06/15.**
5. Electronic bids must be submitted through PPMO’s e-GP system www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp on or before **12:00 noon on 2080/07/01.**
6. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at **12:10 pm on 2080/07/01** at the **Department of Hydrology and Meteorology, Babarmahal, Kathmandu**. Bids must be valid for a period of **90 Days** from the date of bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security or scanned copy of the bid security in pdf format in case of e-bid, amounting to a minimum of **NRs 80,000.00/-** which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
7. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the **bid and** bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
