Department of Hydrology and Meteorology, Babarmahal, Kathmandu on behalf of Ministry of Energy, Water Resources and Irrigation, Government of Nepal invites electronic bids from Nepalese eligible bidders for the construction of " Upgrading of Radar access Road, and Improvement of office building including Radar Tower support Infrastructure at Chitre danda Rautamai-1, Udayapur " under National Competitive Bidding procedures. The estimated amount for the works is Rs. 9653325.95.

- 3. Bidders must submit their bid electronically and may download the bidding documents for e-submission from PPMO's Web Site <u>www.bolpatra.gov.np./egp</u>. Bidders, submitting their bid electronically, should deposit a non-refundable fee of *3000* for the cost of bidding document till *2079.10.20* in the Rajaswa (revenue) account as specified below and the scanned copy (pdf format) of the Bank deposit voucher shall be uploaded by the bidder at the time of electronic submission of the bids. - 4. Electronic bids must be submitted to the office *Department of Hydrology and Meteorology, Babarmahal, Kathmandu* through PPMO website <u>www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp</u> on or before *12 PM* on **2079.10.20**. Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
- 5. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at **12:10 PM** on **2079.10.20**, at the office of Department of Hydrology and Meteorology, Babarmahal, Kathmandu. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days after bid opening and must be accompanied by a scanned copy of the bid security in .pdf format in case of e-bid, amounting to a minimum of 2,90,000, which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
- 6. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid and bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
